- Parking for staff available on site—please ask for a permit.

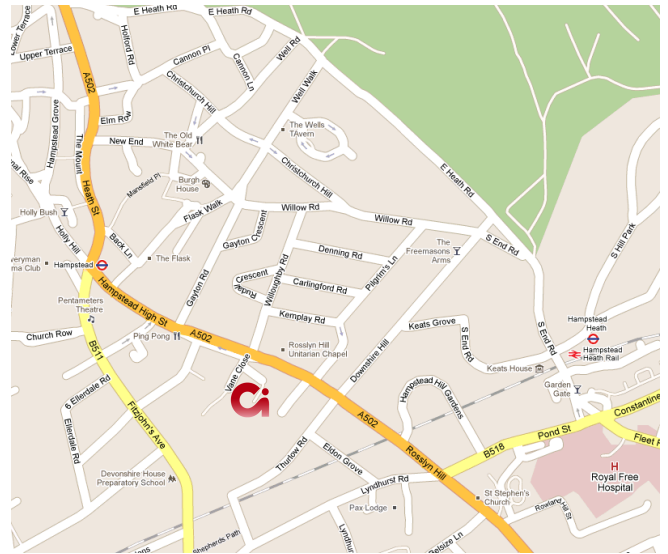
Weekly Underground pass provided for all residential staff.
